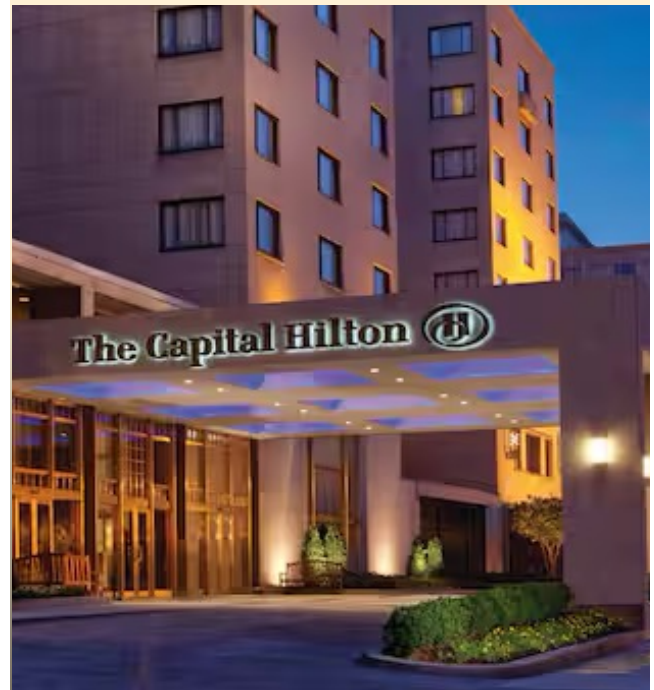

LEADING AT THE SPEED OF AI - Redesigning Work, Building Adaptability, and Creating Enduring Value in an AI-Powered World (OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS)

AI is transforming how organizations operate, how work gets done, how people relate to technology, and how leaders create value. But technology alone will not determine which organizations thrive. The differentiator will be leaders who can see change early, rethink how work gets done, understand the evolving relationship between humans and intelligent technologies, build adaptable organizations, and move from AI experimentation to enterprise impact. This Global Executive Forum brings together senior leaders spanning technology, workforce, human-AI relationships, operations, and enterprise transformation to explore what it means to lead at the speed of AI. The conversation moves beyond what AI can do to confront the larger leadership questions AI creates: How will work change? How will people change? How will our relationships with technology change? What new opportunities and risks will emerge? And what must leaders do now to create value that will endure? **CENTRAL QUESTION:** How do leaders create the velocity required to seize what AI makes possible - while ensuring the integrity, inclusion, and intentionality necessary to create enduring value?
